

ADMISSION CONTRACT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that the MONTGOMERY HOME FOR AGED PEOPLE, INC., a Massachusetts Corporation, duly organized for charitable purposes, hereinafter the "Home", and _____, an applicant to the Home, who has been recommended by the Admission Committee and has been deemed to meet the threshold requirements for admission, and has been duly voted by the Board of Directors; will abide by the probationary term of six (6) months; has paid the set admission fee of \$40,000.00; is hereinafter called the Resident; will pay the sum of \$100.00 per day initially offset from the admission fee (but not to exceed the same) if she is not admitted permanently upon the expiration of the probationary period, or if she becomes incapable of caring for herself, or dies, or decides to leave during the residency.

The Resident agrees to remain responsible for all medical bills and nursing home fees incurred by such Resident and to keep the Home informed as to a responsible person in the event of the disability of said Resident to care for herself, her financial or medical affairs.

Further that said Resident agrees to abide by the rules, regulations and by-laws of the Home at all times and acknowledges that one of said rules is that a responsible person be available at all times, by power of attorney or otherwise, to act on her behalf for all admissions and financial responsibilities occasioned by necessity of a nursing home, hospital or medical care.

In consideration of the above, the Home agrees to furnish room and board at the Home as determined by the Board of Directors acting through its duly appointed Matron, being situated only at 64 South Main Street, Middleborough, Plymouth County, Massachusetts for as long as the Resident is:

alive;
capable of taking care of herself;
not vacant or absent from said Home for a term of 90 days or longer;
not disruptive to the other residents or the management of the Home.

This instruction is deemed to be governed by Massachusetts law and executed as a sealed instrument in duplicate with one copy affixed in the hands of the Home.
